Notes for Applicants

1. Scholarships are provided each year by the AOF for outstanding persons between the ages of 21 and 27.
2. Applicants must be Australian Citizens and may apply for the following award: Work and study overseas for a period of 12 months or longer working in industry, or in a professional capacity, thereby gaining hands-on experience which will be of worthwhile benefit to the applicant upon returning to Australia.
3. Scholarship winners may go Overseas for their agreed period of time in the Industry or Trade that they are engaged. The Foundation has a number of overseas contacts who may be of assistance in arranging employment overseas. Prior to leaving Australia, the successful candidate must conclude arrangements for work or work study to the satisfaction of the Foundation. Whilst employed overseas ,the scholarship winner is entitled to the salary and wages applicable to the work obtained.
4. After discussion with the successful candidate, the Foundation will arrange a financial package to cover Air Fares, settling in expenses etc.
5. Privacy Statement. The Australian Overseas Foundation Inc's privacy policy complies with the National Privacy Principles (NPPs) embodied within the Privacy Amendment Private Sector Act 2000. Your privacy is respected by the Foundation and personal information will be handled in a sensitive manner.
